Tik Tok has many hackers and groomers who want to find out where you live and what your password is. They can pose as your friend . Do you know who is looking at YOU on Tiktok?

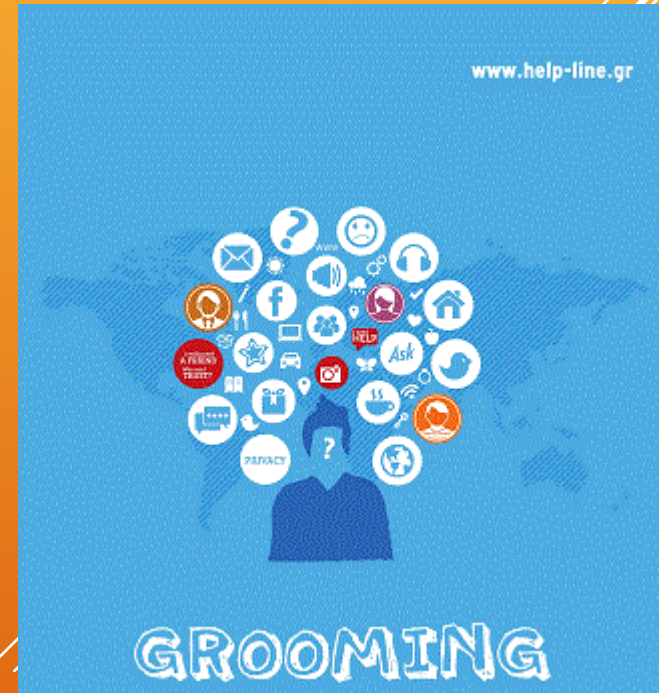

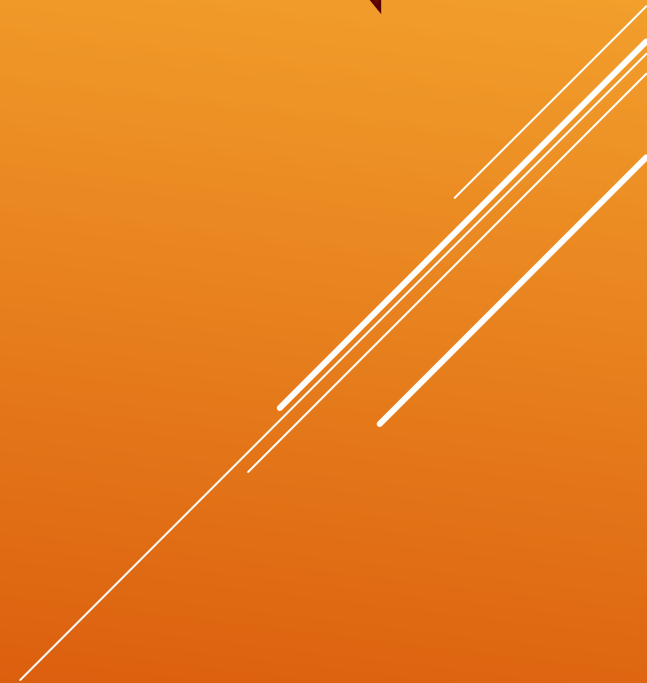
- ▶ This is how groomers work, to make you feel like you are special and they are a new wonderful friend. They are not.

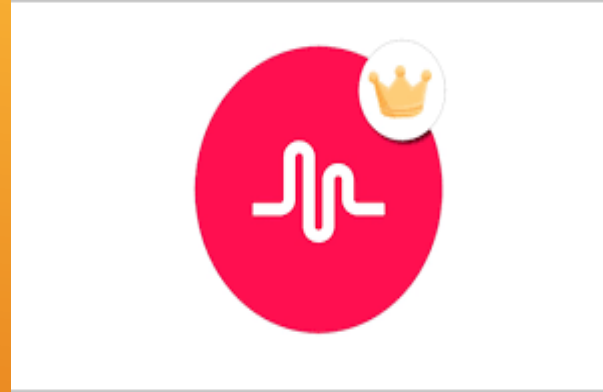
