Creation (EYFS, KS1 and UKS2)

Listen to the story of Creation. What would you like to thank God for?

Families (EYFS, KS1 and LKS2)

Make a collage using family photographs of all the significant family members who show God's love. Write underneath it: "We show God's love to one another." You may want to also include those who have died.

Baptism (EYFS and LKS2)

Talk to someone who has been to a Baptism about their memories of this celebration.

LKS2 - Talk about the signs and symbols of Baptism.

Inspirational People (UKS2)

Write a fact file on a particular saint who strikes you as being inspirational, who lived out the Beatitudes. Explain which Beatitude influenced them the most and how they lived it out.

JUDAISM Pupils will study various aspects of Judaism. Ask them what they have been learning about.

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe (20th November)

Advent (Begins 27th November)

Advent means 'coming'. We think of the coming of Jesus when he was born but we also think of his promise that he would come again at the end of time. It is a time of waiting and preparing. It is only in the last week of Advent that we focus upon the events to be celebrated at Christmas.

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8th December)

This feast marks the first stage of the existence of Mary, the mother of Jesus. She was 'full of grace' from the very beginning and devoted herself to God throughout her life.

Christmas Day, The Nativity of the Lord (25th December)

On this day, we begin our celebration of the birth of Christ.
