Next year pupils in Y1 – Y6 will attend school in their PE Kits on the days which they have PE:

- White T-Shirt
- Blue shorts
- A spare pair of socks
- A pair of trainers – white or black
- A plain black or dark blue unbranded tracksuit top or school jumper
- Plain black or dark blue unbranded joggers
- School tracksuits are available to purchase but this is optional
- If hair is long enough to be tied up, hair tied up – with: blue, yellow or white hair bands
- Tights are not permitted uniform during PE
- All jewellery and watches must be removed for PE. Earrings should not be worn on PE days.
