The month of May is dedicated to Our Lady. **The Ascension of the Lord** (29th May) After his Resurrection, Jesus appeared to his disciples over a period of forty days. Ascension Day is when we celebrate Jesus' return to his Father in Heaven. **Pentecost Sunday** (8th June) This is the day we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church. **The Most Holy Trinity** (15th June) We celebrate our belief in the Trinity, the three persons of God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. **The Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord** (22nd June) On this feast, we give thanks to God for the gift of Jesus in the form of bread and wine. **The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** (27th June) On this day, we remember how much Jesus loves us all. **Saints Peter and Paul** (29th June) We celebrate the lives of these important Saints who helped establish the Christian Church.
