Ofsted Update

We have been working hard to improve our identification of pupils with SEND. As a result, our school SEND register has increased from 6.4% to 9.7%

This half term we have taken the opportunity to ask parents during our parent consultations how they feel the school is doing. The results have been overwhelmingly positive. 98% of parents feel their child is safe, happy, well-behaved and doing well.
