## **Ofsted Update**


We have commenced this term with two external reviews of our provision. These were positive and helpful.

Our Reading curriculum was seen as secure and developed appropriately across the age range. Our focus on reading for pleasure was recognized:

"All pupils have a book club every week. All enjoy the opportunity to share what they are reading and enjoy reading about with their classes."

The feedback on our provision for SEND pupils: "SEND had improved both in visibility and practice, particularly around ease of access to information and recording on Provision Map"

Both reports also contain development points which the school continues to work on.
